

UKRG Annual Workshop, Bournville 2018

Directions to the Beeches, Bournville

The Beeches is conveniently located close to Birmingham City Centre and only minutes from the M5, M6 & M42.

By train

There are connecting trains from Birmingham New Street to Bournville every 10 minutes. Check timetable and fares at www.nationalrail.co.uk.

By taxi or walking from Bournville station

This will cost around £4-00. We suggest you call ahead from the train. The recommended local firm is A Cars on 0121 458 4114. From the station to The Beeches it is 10-minute walk through the village of Bournville. Heading out of the station, turn right onto Mary Vale Road. Then turn right onto Selly Oak Road and keep walking for around five minutes until you see The Beeches on your left.

By car

By car from the M6

Leave the M6 at junction 6 and follow signs to Birmingham City Centre A38 (M). After half a mile turn left onto Bournville Lane. Continue on Bournville Lane for approximately half a mile, then turn left onto Selly Oak Road. The Beeches is situated 100 yards down the road on the left hand side.

By car from the M42

Leave the M42 at junction 2 onto the A441 to Birmingham. At the fifth island in Cotteridge turn into Middleton Hall Road. Take the third right onto Selly Oak Road (just before a set of pedestrian lights). Continue forward over two roundabouts and one crossroads. The Beeches is situated 100 yards down the road on the left hand side.

By car from the M5

Leave the M5 at junction 4 and follow signs for the A38, Birmingham. Turn left onto the A38 (Bristol Road) and continue through the traffic lights at Northfield. After passing Bournville College get into the right hand lane and U-turn through the gap on the dual carriageway heading in the opposite direction. Take your next left onto Bournville Lane. Continue forward for half mile, then turn left onto Selly Oak Road. The Beeches is situated 100 yards down the road on the left hand side.

By air

By air - The closest airport is Birmingham International (BHX) from where there are plenty of trains to Birmingham New Street (see above for how to get from Birmingham New Street to Bournville).
